This is an open workshop where students work on challenging paintings they choose with Susy's guidance.

Each student works on their own painting with Susy moving around the room giving suggestions to each student as they need help. Problems are solved with

Class size: 1 – 12 Ages: 7 - 12

Students will start by learning basics in drawing including using shapes, shading, and design. They will begin painting by using black and white paint to learn shading. The next step is to do a monochromatic painting using a color of their choice with the addition of black and white. Once mastering these skills they can begin making more colorful paintings using a wide range of color based on color theory information. Students can use subject matter of their choice or use subject matter brought by the instructor.

Classes will not be held on the 1st Tuesday of the month.

Fee: \$15 per session

Paints for the first painting will be available, with discussion on the student getting their own set (what to look for, tips for use, etc.)

Class time will be spent learning about different mediums and how to apply them. Student will grow at their own speed with tips and tricks on how to draw. The primary medium will be charcoal, followed by forays into pencil techniques, pen and ink, and once the student has progressed sufficiently, an attempt at an oil painting. The focus will be animals and anatomy, with tidbits on the natural history of the subject chosen. Specialities include elephants, horses, whales and dolphins, dragons, and cats. Please wear clothing that can get dirty: charcoal, ink, and paint can get very messy!

Adult Painting and Drawing

Class size: 1 – 6

Ages: High School through Adult

Students can work toward using watercolor or acrylic paints (water-based paint)

Students will learn to draw objects in a three dimensional manner including shading and learn to compose pleasing compositions. Creating values and form while painting will also be taught. To learn to use colors that work well together, there will be the use of the color wheel in class. Students will work from black and white painting, monochromatic painting, and then more colorful works.
