The Artist's Workshop for Children

Dates: Tues.** Time: 4:00 – 5:00 pm

Fee: \$60 per session (4 classes)

Class size: 1 – 6 Ages: 7 - 12

Session 1: April 12, 19, 26, May 10

Session 2: May 17, 24, 31, June 14

Different artistic skills will be gained by the student. If a specific skill area interests the student more, we will explore artistic ideas connected to that interest. For example: The student may be interested in cartooning so we would explore various art ideas as they relate to cartooning.

Some of the areas of focus would be:

- Drawing and painting animals of the student's choice: Students will begin exploring art by using basic shapes to draw any animal of the student's interest. This is good practice in using basic shapes, volume, proportions, line, and detail. Students will begin by drawing the animal, giving it detail and can move to giving the animal color in a later painting.
- Cartooning: Cartooning is great for developing personal expression. The student will learn first to draw the human figure and face and will then practice distorting these to create their own cartoon character. Cartoons may include people and animal cartoons and learning to create your own comic strips.
- Landscape: Basic rules of creating a landscape will be taught. Students will learn how to draw and paint trees, grounds, and other spatial concepts so they can feel confident in creating any landscape.
- Perspective: The student will learn the rules of perspective including one and two point perspective, and atmospheric perspective. The student can expect to be able to draw houses

and buildings that have correct angles.

- Learning to draw the figure and the face: The student will learn rules to how to draw and paint the human figure and face. Self portraits can be a part of this lesson.
- Learning about color: Complimentary colors, analogous colors, monochromatic colors. The student will learn about color starting with a monochromatic painting to get used to lights and darks, learn how to use complimentary colors to give the painting life, and analogous colors to provide harmony in the painting. Fruits and vegetables will be the still life. Please wear clothes you don't mind getting paint on. Please call ahead if you can't make a lesson and Scott will provide a make up lesson. Supply list available at front desk.

Students can expect to learn specific art skills while also developing each skill below with confidence. Learning to work with basic shapes, values (lights and darks), and drawing with pencils, painting techniques, use of pastels, working with acrylics, and watercolor and getting inspiration from still lifes are just some

of the experiences the adult student will have a chance to learn.

- **Drawing and painting animals of the student's choice:** Students will begin exploring art by using basic shapes to draw any animal of the student's interest.. This is good practice in using basic shapes, volume, proportions, line, and detail. Students will begin by drawing the animal, giving it detail and can move to giving the animal color in a later painting.
 - **Cartooning:** Cartooning is great for developing personal expression.
