### Three Dimensional Magic for Children

Dates: Tues.\*\* Time: 4:00 – 5:00 pm

Fee: \$60 per session (\$15 per classes)

Class size: 1 – 6 Ages: 7 - 13

Session 1: January 9, 16, 23, 30

Session 2: February 13, 20, 27, March 13

Create a picture that is made up of three 5" x 7" paintings or drawings. Each triptych, which is a series of three paintings, should tell a story featuring a beginning, middle, and end. Students can really let their imaginations go with this project. The finished product can be easily framed with frames found at Michaels.

Ideas for triptychs: Paint a landscape that spans out three picture frames or connecting an object that reaches through three frames and many more ideas the students have.

Please wear clothes you don't mind getting paint on.  
Please let the instructor know 24 hours in advance if you cannot attend a class

# Children's and Adult Classes

## Painting for Fun with Susy Halverson

Dates: Wednesdays, starting January 10th

Time: Adults 1:00 – 3:00 pm

Children 3:30 – 5:00 pm

Fee: \$15 per day if using Susy's supplies

\$12 per day if using your own materials

Includes a canvas up to 18x24 for all students.

Ages: 12 through Adult All skill levels welcome!

Class size: 1 - 7

Have you ever wondered if you could paint a beautiful painting but were afraid to try. It's more possible than you think and Susy can show you how.

Come prepared to have fun with water mixable oil paint. Susy specializes in landscapes and waterscapes but students paint what they desire with guidance. Susy guides each student where and when they need it in a very positive and fun way. Her sense of humor and love of painting keep everyone laughing and learning. Students may bring regular oil paints but are asked to clean their brushes at home.

## Creating Hand-Made Books

Dates: Thursdays, January 11, 18, 25, February 8, 15, 22

Time: 5:30 – 7:30 pm Ages: 14 through Adult

Fee: \$20 per class or \$100 for all 6 classes

Class size: 4 – 10. If a minimum of 4 students are not signed up by the Tuesday before the class, the class will be cancelled.

Supplies: Students will need to bring a pair of sharp scissors, a ruler, and a pencil. All other supplies will be provided.

This course is offered as a series of six classes. All participants must take Class #1, Decorating and Designing Papers before taking any of the book classes so they have papers to use in constructing the different books. In addition to Class #1, you may sign up for any number of the others.

*January 11* – Decorating and Designing Papers - use folding/dying, paste painting, collage, eraser printing, and stenciling to create beautiful papers for use with hand-made books.

*January 18* – Accordion Book - Learn how to construct an accordion or concertina book with a tie.

*January 25* – Two Books: Stick Binding and Japanese Stab Binding - Make two books—the first is one with simple sticks and rubber bands and the second with hard covers and stitching.

*February 8* – Signatures and How to Sew Them - Create a sewn signature book with a spine.

*February 15* – Using Bamboo Sticks in a Book Binding - A single signature book with recessed bamboo sticks.

*February 22* – A Book with a Wrap-Around Cover and Closure. A book that could be used as a Journal or sketchbook.

## **Pen & Ink Drawing – Ink and Watercolor Classes**

All levels of drawing skills welcomed.

Session 2: March 5, 12, 19

Learn to use your drawing skills with a new medium that's very portable. It's an affordable medium that can be fun and unique. You learn to develop an image and begin to add more texture lines to develop detailed areas of your drawing. Session 1 is just pen and ink while session 2 will be adding color using watercolor or watercolor pencil.

### **Three Dimensional Drawing for Adults**

Session 1: January 8, 22, 29, February 5

Session 2: February 12, 26, March 5, 12

The student will use tricks to make their painting three-dimensions. This would include using lights and darks, perspective, bright colors vs. duller color and learning to use the color wheel. Students will be encouraged to paint from actual objects and are encouraged to bring objects they would like to paint. Much can be learned by painting and drawing from actual objects.
