## Children's and Adult Classes

### *Oil Painting Techniques to Make You Great!*

Date: Wednesdays Time: 1:00 – 5:00 pm\*\*

Session 1: October 3, 10, 17, 24

Session 2: November 22, 28, Dec. 5, 12

Cost: \$15 per day for students using Susy's paints and brushes

\$12 per day for students who bring their own supplies

Class size: 3-6 Ages: 8 and up

\*\*Students choose a 2-hour time period for adults and a 1.5-hour time period for 15 and under.

Come have fun with water clean-up oil paints. Susy challenges her students to grow while allowing them choices in subjects. It's always an adventure to paint with Susy. Students learn by experiencing the concepts of perspective, color mixing, brush techniques and how to lay out a great design. If you have a painting you are working on but got stuck or uninspired, bring it to class for help.

## Adult Classes

### *Watercolor Adventure*

Session 1: October 9, 16, 23

Session 2: November 13, 20, 27

Cost: \$40 per session (3 classes)

Class size: 3-7 Ages: 18 and up

This watercolor adventure is meant to give you a longer time to develop your skills so you can tackle any subject of your choice.

Session 1 will begin with landscape and floral subjects. We will review basic and semi-advanced techniques. If you have a favorite scene or flower you want to paint, bring examples to the session. We will also be using two different surfaces-watercolor paper (140 lb) and Bristol paper (100 lb).

Session 2 will be dealing with animals and seasonal subjects. We will expand upon your skills with each session. You may also want to explore using other mediums such as pen and ink or gauche with the watercolor. Again, if there is a certain animal or seasonal subject, please bring it.

Students are encouraged to attend both sessions as there will be no repetition of subject matter. Each session deals with different techniques so you can attend one session or both.

All levels encouraged to attend. All materials and supplies will be available but feel free to bring any of your own.

### *Walking through the Color Wheel for Adults*

Class size: 1-6 Ages: 18 and up

Scott McRae will share what he knows about the color wheel and tricks in using it that he has found successful over the years. In this class expect to learn the very basics in using color and color mixing while not becoming overwhelmed. Each lesson will explore one color theory concept at a time so that the student can begin to feel confident in painting. Acrylic paints will be used in this class because of the versatility.

## Children's Classes

### *Drawing and Colors for Children*

Dates: Tuesdays\*    Time: 4:00 – 5:00 pm

Session 1: October 9, 16, 24, Nov. 13

Session 2: November 20, 27, Dec. 11, 18

Fee: \$60 per session (4 classes)

Class size: 1 – 6    Ages: 7 – 13

This class brings together basic drawing skills and combines them with color theory. For example, the student can learn to draw animals while experimenting with the various colors to bring that animal to life. Perspective drawing can lend itself to light and dark colors. Painting fruits can be connected to the primary colors. Students use acrylic paints or other color materials as well as drawing materials such as pencil and charcoal.
