Mixed Media for Children

Chinese Brush Painting

Class Size: 3 - 8

Experience the freedom of brush strokes that create images such as bamboo, branches, Cherry blossoms, and more. Chinese brush painting involves special bamboo brushes, ink stone, colored ink and rice paper. All these tools and supplies will be available for your use during the class. You will learn the basic holds of the brush, preparation of the ink, application techniques and composition of a typical Chinese painting.

Supplies, aprons and gloves will be provided as needed by the instructor.

Clay: Small Garden Pond
