## Children's Classes

### ART BASICS FOR CHILDREN

Drawing from photographs will also be a part of this class based on what the student wants to draw and paint.

## OIL PAINTING

This oil painting class will focus on animals, composition, anatomy, and color. Specific focus will be showing how to create an engaging composition and on animal anatomy of the chosen subject. If the student has some experience with oil paints, the focus will be on teaching them more about painting style and also giving suggestions on new techniques they might try to improve their own style. Novice students will start with basics (this includes a drawing lesson combined with a painting class) and work up through several sessions until they feel more comfortable with the medium. The goal is to explore the paints and have the artist develop their own style while learning about the animals they are painting.

The student can also expect to learn how color creates a sense of depth and how the use of dark colors and light colors can add to the perspective of a painting. Scott will share his color ideas in this class.
