Prospectus

The show is open to all who are interested. There are separate categories for children 17 and under, adults, and BG members. All media, both 2D and 3 D are accepted.

All items must be hand crafted by the exhibitor. Student class work, copies of other work, or commercial kits will not be accepted. Artwork must be completed in the last two years. Please have art framed and wired for hanging. (Gallery maintains right to refuse art deemed unsuitable).

Artwork for wall display may be not larger than 36" by 40". 3D objects may not have a footprint larger than 18" x 18". All wall work must be ready to hang with a wire on the back.

Each piece must be accompanied by an ENTRY TAG and ready to display when delivered. No wet or incomplete work will be accepted.

If entry items are for sale, the price needs to be clearly stated on the ENTRY TAG. The Broadway Gallery will handle all sales and will retain a 35% commission fee.

Application Instructions "A Place for Hope" Art Show

1. Fill out the show application (attached) and sign and date the release statement.
2. Fill out the information on the ENTRY TAG for each piece you enter.
3. Bring the completed application with payment of the entry fee of \$5 per item. Limited to 3 pieces per artist.
