General Art Skills for Children

Teacher: Scott McRae

Dates: Tuesdays

Time: 4:00-5:00 pm

Dates: August 6, 13, 20, 27 (Session 1)

September 3, 10, 17, 24 (Session 2)

Fee: \$60 per session

Class Size: 1-4 Ages: 8 and up

Description: Students will learn drawing and painting skills they can use the rest of their lives. Such skills would include being able to draw anything by using basic shapes such as painting plant still lives, figure drawing, perspective drawing, and drawing animals. The student can expect the instructor to guide them through the drawing and then time to create watercolor paintings adding their own flare to the topic.

Adult Classes Landscapes and Flowers for Adults

Fees: \$80 per session

Class Size: 1-4 **Ages:** 18 plus

Description: Learn to paint flower, landscapes, and landscapes with flowers. Students are encouraged to bring photos of a landscape and flowers they want to paint and draw. Other imagery will come from library books.

Students can expect to be guided through their drawing and painting as well as adding their own special flare to their art. They can expect to learn drawing and painting techniques.

Description: Ever just need some help how to approach starting or finishing an art project? Now you can get advice and have someone demonstrate for you. Get advice on what materials work best, where to start and how to use a technique to help.

Students can select their own subject and receive help to create their own final piece

in watercolor, acrylics, gouache or pen and ink. Bring your own paints, paper or canvas and brushes or use the teacher's supplies. You may purchase paper or canvas from the teacher.
