Drawing Animals for Children

Teacher: Scott McRae

Dates: Tuesdays

Time: 4:00-5:00 pm

Dates: October 8, 15, 22; November 12
(Session)

Fee: \$60 per session

Class Size: 1-4 **Ages:** 8 and up

Description: Students will learn ways to draw and paint animals. They will learn skills they can use the rest of their lives. Such skills would include being able to draw anything by using basic shapes such as painting landscapes and animals. The student can expect the instructor to guide them through the drawing and then have time to create watercolor paintings adding their own flare to the topic.

Class Size: 1-4 **Ages:** 18 plus

Description: Learn to outdoor landscapes including trees and mountains. Students are encouraged to bring photos of what they want to paint and draw. Other imagery will come from library books.

Students can expect to be guided through their drawing and painting as well as adding their own special flare to their art. They can expect to learn drawing and painting techniques.

Open Drop-In Water-Media Class

Fees: \$25 per day with your supplies; \$30 per day with teacher's supplies

Description: Ever just need some help how to approach starting or finishing an art project? Now you can get advice and have someone demonstrate for you. Get advice on what materials work best, where to start and how to use a technique to help.

Students can select their own subject and receive help to create their own final piece

in **watercolor and acrylics**. Bring your own paints, paper or canvas and brushes or use the teacher's supplies. You may purchase paper or canvas from the teacher.

Drawing with Pencil and Colored Pencil

Description: Students start working in graphite pencil to capture their subject of choice. half way through we'll switch to colored pencil and learn some blending techniques .
