Description: What you can't achieve with one medium, you can easily achieve with another. For example, the veins in a leaf or bark on a tree can easily be created with oil pastel and watercolors as oil pastels resist watercolor leaving behind beautiful textural marks. A simple practice of outlining trees and buildings with a fine tipped Sharpie marker can be just the right touch to make a successful painting. This class will explore watercolor painting as the main medium, but students will also explore pastels, fine tipped markers, oil pastels and other materials to bring their painting to life.

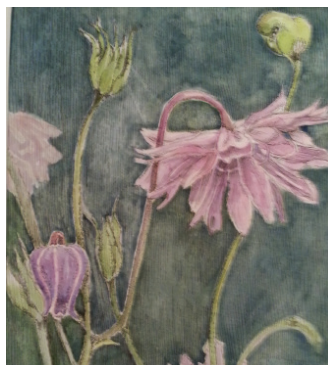

This class will cover the ABC's of watercolor painting (flat washes, graded washes, and glazing), practice with how to use round and flat tipped brushes, and several easy fear conquering exercises to get you painting right away. To show depth in your painting, some tips on how to use perspective drawing will also be covered. Come learn how to paint trees, water, buildings, and other subjects with this versatile medium.
