Description: Students will learn to create paintings using the mixed media approach of using watercolors and acrylics. After learning some technique with watercolors, the student will paint a fruit bowl still life using the watercolor medium. Next, they will add more detail and texture with the acrylic paint. Students will discover how to make colorful and exciting paintings using these two mediums together. Once the student has gained confidence using the two mediums, they will make paintings inspired from established artist's paintings and illustrations.

**Painting from Master Watercolor
Artists for Adults**

Description: Basic watercolor techniques will be taught in this class to get the student the tools necessary to create a painting. Such skills would be different ways to hold a paintbrush, solid washes, gradated washes, glazing, and using dark and light colors.

In this class, students will select a watercolor painting from an established artist and then paint a picture using similar watercolor techniques. Students will first make a value drawing of the selected painting with soft pencil to learn where the darks and lights are in the painting and to achieve the basic composition of the painting. Next, the student will transfer that drawing to watercolor paper and begin painting from the established artist's work.

Description: Discover some of the easy techniques for drawing various subjects using a variety of mediums- pencil, charcoal, colored pencil, and ink. You'll gain skills on drawing from different perspectives, creating dimension, and showing individual differences of similar objects

Whether you're beginning your drawing skills or adding to your experience with the mediums, you'll be ready to tackle new subjects of your own. Students need to bring or purchase a 9x12 Strathmore drawing pad for documenting your progress. Drawing supplies will be provided by the teacher. You may want to buy some later to use at home.
