Collage Card Making

Beginning Watercolor for Adults

Students can expect to learn from step by step instruction. Master artists will be examined to help enrich technique and expand the student's individual creativity.

Small Painting in Watercolor & Ink

Description: Learn to mix two mediums and create small paintings as gifts or décor around the house. Subjects will vary each session and you can take home a finished piece. We'll be practicing various techniques to help you develop your own style. You are welcome to bring your own subject matter or a current artwork you're working on for advice.

Session 2 you may explore completing larger pieces that may take 2 classes to complete or you can work in the same way as Session 1.
